## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE





## THE HEAT IS ON!

Dear neighbors,

As I write this message, summer has just officially begun here in beautiful Marion County. Once again, we can expect to adjust the rhythm of our daily lives by concentrating our outdoor activities in the early morning and late afternoons. It's all part of life in Central Florida, but right now October seems so very far away...

The heat is on in your Association as well. Our goal this year is to increase the pool of potential leadership. We believe that diversity of backgrounds, opinions, and experiences will strengthen and improve the organization.

One step in this direction is to fill each of the three standing committee chair positions that have been vacant for more than three years. Committee work does not require a huge commitment of time, and is usually done only on an asneeded basis. The chair can identify annual goals or not; the committee can meet regularly or infrequently; they can conduct business face-to-face or virtually. Since committee chairs are encouraged to attend Board and Association meetings, committee chairmanship is also a great way to get a close-up look at how the work of the Association is accomplished without having to be a direct participant.

Regarding Association support, each committee is permitted to request up to \$250 per year from the Executive Board, and may take requests for larger amounts to the membership for approval at a general Association meeting.

In upcoming newsletters, we will profile the three vacant chair positions for the Beautification, Control, and Membership committees. In the meantime, feel free to contact any member of the Board with questions. Committee work is easy, fun, and a low-intensity way to step up and do a little bit for your neighborhood.

One small housekeeping note: for the next fiscal year (June 2016-May 2017), we will have Board Meetings only in July, September, November, January, March and May, rather than every month. The Board meetings will take place one week prior to the bimonthly general Association meetings. Of course, the Board reserves the right to call a meeting in "off" months if necessary. Watch your newsletter and the signs at the East and West entrances for all meeting notifications.

In closing, I'd like to thank everyone who has welcomed me back to the position of President. I truly am humbled by your confidence. Let's keep our neighborhood and our Association moving forward—together.

## IMPORTANT—Check Your New Voter Registration Card!

Sometime in June, every registered voter in Marion County received a new Voter Registration card from the Supervisor of Elections. This mailing was necessary due to court-mandated redistricting that affected a number of voters. In our case in Meadow Wood Farms, most of our information remains the same, including our Precinct Number (2600) and our polling location, St. Johns United Methodist Church on Highway 328.

However, it is important to take a close look at the printed card to ensure that your registration information is correct, complete, and up to date. The next election will be held on <u>Tuesday, August 30<sup>th</sup></u>, and once again it is a Closed Primary election. This means that in order to vote for state or local candidates from a particular political party, YOU MUST be registered as a member of that party. Many people were turned away from the Presidential Preference Primary in March because they were not registered as either Republican or Democrat. In general (November) elections, your party affiliation does not matter, but in primaries it is all-important.

So please, check either the card you received in the mail, or call the Supervisor of Elections at **352-620-3290** to verify your party affiliation. Changes in your registration may be made until midnight on **August 1**, **2016**. After that, the registration records cannot be changed until after the August 30<sup>th</sup> Primary.
