

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What Attracted Us to Meadow Wood Farms?

In 2002, Dave and I took a four-day exploration trip to central Florida to see if we could find someplace where we might want to retire. We were living in St. Petersburg at the time and even though St. Pete is a beautiful city and we loved our home, we thought we might want to explore a less crowded, more sedate setting for our later years. It was during that four-day exploration that we picked up a free real estate magazine containing current home listings. There was one of a geodesic home, a style which has always been intriguing to Dave, in an area called Meadow Wood Farms. We contacted the listing agent, set up an appointment to meet with him and toured the home that very weekend.

Although the geodesic home wasn't suitable for our needs, we were very impressed with the neighborhood. There was an energy about it; it felt and looked appealing. Three weekends later, the real estate agent arranged several more homes to tour in different areas around Ocala to give us a better selection of neighborhoods, even showing us one home in Summerfield.

The only home we previewed in Meadow Wood Farms that second weekend in Ocala was located at 94 Lake View Drive East. Even to this day, I vividly remember sitting in the back seat of the realtor's car as we parked in front of what is now our home. A little yellow butterfly flitted and danced just outside my car window as we sat listening to the agent describe the property.

The realtor introduced us to a lovely family that owned it. The house was built in 1979 so it needed some updating, but we planned to rent it anyway until we would be able to move here upon retirement. It wasn't until we walked the property that we knew with certainty this was where we wanted to live. The majestic trees, the beauty of nature, the sounds of birds, and most of all, the energy of peace that emanated from the earth and permeated the silence.

We purchased our home on October 31, 2002, and easily rented it. The few times between renters provided us with the excitement of spending nights in our home, sleeping on a blowup mattress on the floor in the living room while taking bicycle rides through the neighborhood each day we were able to spend here. We met our wonderful neighbors across the street, Don and Mary Jo Ivey, longtime residents of MWF. We loved it and couldn't wait to move to Meadow Wood Farms.

I truly believe our hearts' desires were being answered when in December of 2006, the company where Dave had been an employee for nearly 20 years announced that they were closing their offices in Florida. At first it was a shock, the timing right before Christmas was stunning. But wishes really do come true. The very first employer Dave interviewed with offered him a position with one caveat – it required a relocation to Ocala! We truly love living in Meadow Woods Farms.

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


