



What If?

My wife and I attended church this morning as we often, but not always, do. While the specifics of the message were not particularly remarkable, the guest pastor posed a question that I found quite thought provoking. "What if God moved into your neighborhood, perhaps right next door?" As I thought about this question in the context of MWF, several other questions came to mind.

Before anyone throws up their hands in protest, I assure you that it matters little to me what faith you may follow. The questions that popped into my head only need the belief that your faith, should you have it, is of the monotheistic variety; Christian, Jewish, Buddhist, Islam, Hindu or whatever. Ask yourself, "what if my God moved in next door?" How would you act differently? How would Meadow Wood Farms be different? If you are honest with yourself, as I am trying to be, would you act differently? Would you BE a different person? Would your neighbors act differently? I reluctantly suspect, at least in my case, that I would be different and act differently.

Again, regardless of your faith, each of the major monotheistic faiths share the notion that all of creation is linked together in a fundamental and inalterable way and that, to paraphrase the Christian "Golden Rule," we should treat everyone else as we would like to be treated. Certainly, reality would tell us that there are many radical and/or fundamentalist off-shoots of the all principal faiths whose members don't seem to ascribe to that concept, but it is still a basic tenet of each of these faiths.

So, how would you be different? How would MWF be different if our newest neighbor were God? Would we be more neighborly? Would we get to know each other better? Would we seek out opportunities to serve and help each other and our community? Would we be more considerate, maybe driving slower and more carefully lest we encounter walkers, horse riders, cyclists, or children playing in the street? Would we refrain from gossip (which is so much easier and more prevalent with social media)? Would we be more faithful – to our spouses, our friends, and our community? Would we resist worrying about the little things like "keeping up with the Jones's" and put our faith and energy into the things in life that really matter like the connections and links to our fellow travelers on planet Earth? Would we "judge not lest we be judged?"

The list goes on and on. I can only speak for me, and I really do try to be the best person I can be in this context. But, I guarantee you that I can do better. And, if God moved in next door, I'm pretty certain I'd be even more diligent to live the way my God wants me to.

Just think...what if?
I know I am.
